ABOUT

Ponytail palms are slow growers that are low maintenance & care free plants. Despite their name, they are not Palms at all but members of the Agave family. Perfect for beginners & those who have less time on their hands.

LIGHT & WATER

- Provide bright but indirect light. They will tolerate lower light areas but grow slower
- Water every 2-3 weeks. They store water in the trunk and need less frequent watering.
- Provide quality well-drained potting soil and a pot with adequate drainage.

TIPS

- Fertilize once or twice a year in the Spring/Summer months with a gentle fertilizer
- Use sharp scissors to snip off brown tips that may develop on the ends of the leaves
- Only repot once rootbound into a pot that is just 1-2" larger. It may be several years in between repottings.
